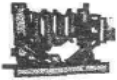

To be a member of our Club and to enjoy our meetings, you don't necessarily have to be an expert photographer. The main requirement is that you have an interest in photography.

Our programme covers a diverse range of photographic subjects and we invite a number of visiting lecturers to give talks and practical demonstrations of photographic techniques and to also show us their work. We aim to make sure that our programme contains something of interest for everyone.

Competitions and critique evenings are held regularly for member's prints and images. Our members produce pictures from digital cameras, film cameras, from trade processed prints, from home computers, from their own darkrooms and so on. The competitions are divided into three classes for Standard, Intermediate and Advanced workers.

Whether you are a beginner, or an experienced photographer, and want help on any facet of photography, advice is always readily available from our own experts to help you improve your techniques.

Each year we hold an Annual Exhibition and as a member you would be entitled to have your work exhibited in public.

The Club is a member of the South London Federation of Photographic Societies and, also, the Surrey Photographic Association through which we are affiliated to the Photographic Alliance of Great Britain. Our members are thus able to participate in the activities run by these organisations.
